Job Pack

Carefully read the information included in the Job Pack for the role you are interested in. It will help you decide if the role is a good match for you, your experience and your skills. The job description and person specification will detail what the successful candidate will need to demonstrate throughout the application and interview process.

To apply, please complete the appropriate application form.

Supporting Statement

Your supporting statement should explain what attracts you to the role at Sadler's Wells, how your skills and experience match the person specification in the Job Pack and any other information which demonstrates why you are the ideal candidate for the role.

Personal Skills

This is your opportunity to demonstrate the skills that will help you to perform well in the role. Consider the criteria in the Job Pack and use this section to list any skills you have developed and demonstrated in your previous work, volunteering, training, education or personal life that are relevant to your application.

Employment & Work Experience Record

These sections should support and demonstrate the skills and competencies you have already told us about. Provide any relevant details for each position, such as specific duties, skills learned or training undertaken that will support your application.

Education & Other Qualifications

In this section, give details on any formal education or qualifications you have obtained that support and enhance your application.

References

All offers of employment are subject to the receipt of satisfactory references.

You should provide up-to-date contact information for two referees (one of whom should be your most recent employer or school). Your referees should know of your professional work and be able to endorse the skills and experience you have mentioned in the application.
